Keith Longbotham began playing guitar as a boy in Texas. But Music City is the place that ultimately shaped his career.

Keith moved to Nashville in 1982 to join a bluegrass show at Opryland USA, a musical theme park. For the next eight years, he not only entertained fans, he also attracted the attention of country music legends, Roy Acuff and Porter Wagoner. Soon he was invited to play with Acuff and Wagoner at the Grand Ole Opry. He went on to play many Opry shows and appeared often on The Nashville Network.

In 1984 Keith began to travel to Arizona to perform for the resorts there. His first year He performed for only three small resorts. The next year he performed for seven resorts. The next year it was 20 and then his show exploded as he performed for over 60 resorts the following year. Today his show is still popular averaging around 50 shows each year in Arizona. Audiences love his mix of country, bluegrass, gospel and patriotic tunes all seasoned with a generous helping of humor.
